- Scouting is a moral compass that will guide our youth throughout their lifetime.

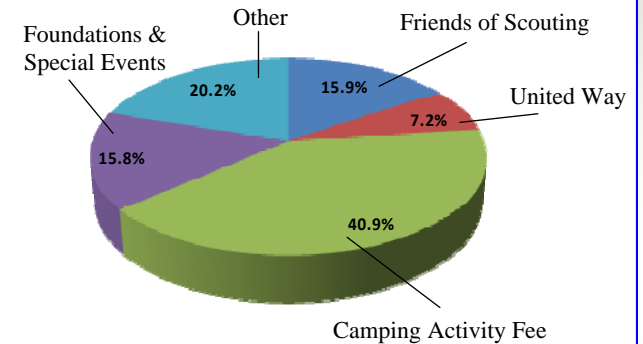
